Consultation – Central Acute Services Building at Westmead

As you may be aware, in early May NSW Premier Gladys Berejiklian announced that major construction on our 14-storey Central Acute Services Building (CASB) at Westmead had been completed three months ahead of schedule. The early handover was intended to help us manage any COVID-19 surges in Western Sydney.

Works on the CASB have continued and Western Sydney Local Health District (WSLHD) are in a position to commence discussions regarding the transition of services to the CASB.
