

DETERMINATION No 19 of 2019

NON-STANDARD CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT ARRANGEMENT FOR MEDICAL OFFICERS ON PREVOCATIONAL OR VOCATIONAL TRAINING ROTATIONS, IN AN ACCREDITED FACILITY, OUTSIDE OF NSW HEALTH

In accordance with the provisions of section 116A(1) of the *Health Services Act 1997* and delegation s117 of the NSW Ministry of Health's Combined Delegations Manual, the Ministry of Health make the following determination:

- Time worked in an accredited facility outside of NSW Health, as directed as part of a medical officer's prevocational and or vocational training program, will not break continuity of service with NSW Health for the purposes of paid maternity, paternal and adoption leave. Time worked in an accredited facility outside of NSW Health will not count as service with NSW Health for all other purposes. Medical Officers will be required to submit supporting documentation to substantiate the rotational requirement from the relevant medical college.

This non-standard condition of employment arrangement is not to be used as a precedent and is not transferrable to any other classification in the NSW Health Service.
