PARLIAMENT HOUSE - 12:00 - 16 NOVEMBER



CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. Unfortunately you are unable to participate in the event if:
 - you are unwell and experiencing flu like symptoms cannot participate in the event. If you are unwell you should immediately be tested for COVID-19. The nearest testing centre to NSW Parliament House is the Sydney Eye Hospital, 8 Macquarie Street Sydney;
 - you have had a close contact with a COVID-19 positive case;
 - you have visited known suburbs with a high prevalence of COVID-19 cases over the last 14 days;
 - You are awaiting COVID-19 test results; or
 - You or anyone in your household has been directed to self-isolate.
2. In order to participate in today's event you are required to provide contact details through either the sign-in sheet or QR code provided.
3. Participants sanitise their hands thoroughly prior to attending the event.
4. Participants must maintain social distancing by keeping a distance of 1.5 metres between non-household contacts.
5. All participants are encouraged to wear face masks at all time.
6. All participants should comply with the directions of Unions NSW staff and volunteers regarding social distancing and COVID-19 compliance.
7. Chanting and singing should comply with the current NSW Health advice. If you unaware of this advice please ask a Unions NSW staff member or volunteer on entry.
8. Microphones and loud hailers or other such equipment should not be shared by participants during the protest.
9. Participants should bring their own food and drinks and should not share water bottles or snacks.
10. Unions NSW requests that all participants disperse immediately following the protest via various access points.
